## PROTOCOL

# CLEANSE + PREP

Prepare skin by cleansing with Corthe Essential Foaming Gel Cleanser. Perform extractions if needed.

# TREATMENT STEPS

1. Cleanse skin with Corthe Foaming Gel Cleanser as a first cleanse.
